

Thinking Abilities and General Knowledge Activity for 18 to 24 Months

Symbol to Thing

This is a fun activity to help children learn that a picture is a symbol that represents a real thing.

Materials:

- Old toy catalog with pictures of the child's toys
- Thin cardboard or heavy paper
- Clear contact paper
- Scissors

What to do:

- 1. Let the child help you find pictures of his toys in the catalog.
- 2. Cut out the pictures, mount them on the cardboard and cover with clear contact paper for durability.
- 3. Hand one of the pictures to the child and ask him to find that object among his toys

Variations:

- A. Put the mounted pictures in a grab bag and let the child reach in and take out a picture.
- B. See if you can find pictures in magazines of other things you have in your home even if they aren't exactly the same, such as a clock, a rocking chair, a sink, a toilet, or a plant. See if the child can generalize from the picture and find the object that serves the same function in the room.

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
