261,801 new, age-appropriate books mailed to Alaska children at no cost to their families

23,378 children enrolled in Imagination Library received a book each month in the mail

90% of parents responding to a survey reported receiving Imagination Library books increased the amount of time they spent reading with their child

12,802 individuals attended family engagement events and activities put on by Best Beginnings and Imagination Libraries serving children across Alaska

93% of parents responding to family engagement event surveys reported increased knowledge of parenting and child development

7,172 unique Alaska individuals accessed educational resources and information through the Best Beginnings website





Investing in Alaska's most valuable resource - its children

Alaska Imagination Libraries spent \$548,407 on books and postage in FY 2016.



Estimated market value of books distributed through Imagination library in Alaska is \$1,617,930.

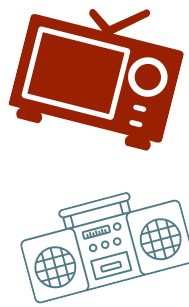
\$1,000,000 in cost savings was realized delivering high-quality books into the hands and homes of tens of thousands of Alaska children through Imagination Library.

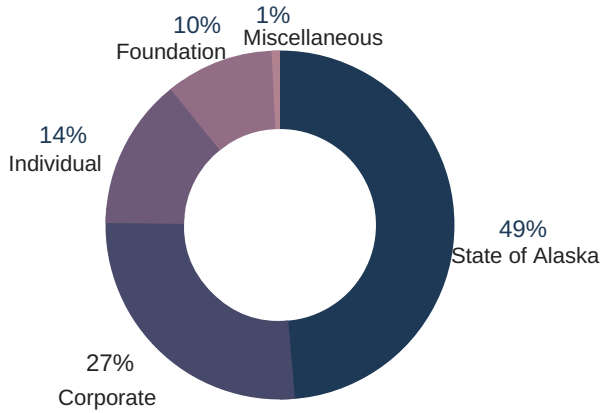
Thousands of volunteer hours donated at a value of \$23.56 per hour ensure more children and families are served.

Best Beginnings Financial Summary FY 2016

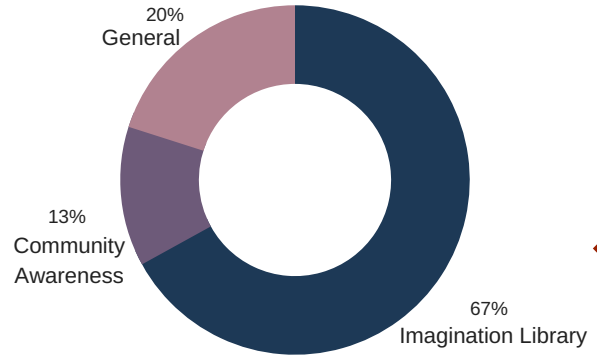
