A five-year-old with these skills is **READY** to succeed at school.

1 Letters and Sounds:

- enjoys being read to and can retell a story
- names 10-15 letters and their sounds
- repeats the first sound in a word
- speaks in complete sentences
- prints his or her first name

2 Math:

- counts in order from 1-20
- recognizes numbers and quantities to 5
- names and sorts items by color, shape and size
- understands concepts such as more, less, same, above, below, big, small

3 Social:

- settles in to new groups or situations
- can concentrate on a task for 5 minutes
- follows simple directions
- shows kindness and concern for others



Reading together 20 minutes a day helps your child master these skills.
