

Communication, Language, and Literacy Activity for 6 to 12 Months

Mama, Dada

At this age, babies begin to associate language with people and things.

Materials:

• Large photographs of mommy, daddy, and other relatives.

What to do:

- 1. Arrange large photographs of mommy, daddy, and other relatives the baby knows next to the crib, highchair, and changing area.
- 2. Point to the picture and say, "This is Daddy," when the baby starts making sounds like "dada."
- 3. Point to the pictures at other times and use the person's name in a sentence: "Mommy loves you." "Grandma is coming today."
