



## Thinking Abilities and General Knowledge Activity for 30 to 36 Months

### Photographic Sequencing Game

**Materials:**

- Digital camera or camera and film
- Clear self-adhesive plastic

**What to do:**

1. Take pictures of the child engaged in daily routines and transitions: saying hello, washing hands, morning snack, bathroom time, play time, putting on outdoor clothing, playing outside, taking off outdoor clothing, setting the table, eating lunch.
2. Encase the printed or developed pictures individually in clear self-adhesive plastic for durability.
3. Help the child arrange the pictures in the sequence of when they happen in your daily routine. Talk to her as she does this. "What do we do first each day?" "What do we do after snack?" This is a difficult concept, but the child will enjoy lining up the pictures whether she gets the sequence correct.
