

Thinking Abilities and General Knowledge Activity for 6 to 12 Months

This Goes with That

Materials:

 Objects that have some relationship with each other (hairbrush and doll, wash cloth and soap, cup and saucer)

What to do:

- 1. Select two pairs of objects that the child frequently sees you using together. Place the objects in front of the infant and say, "Let's play bath time" or "Let's have tea. Give me what we need." Watch the child search for the correct objects. Try to provide hints to help the child make her selections.
- 2. Place about three of the pairs of objects before the child and remove one object once the child can complete several one-to-one relationships. Tell the child, "Find the one that goes with ______."
