



## **Approaches to Learning Activity for 36 to 42 Months**

### **Tissue Paper Collages**

*This activity provides children with the opportunity to experiment and be creative. It also provides experience with cutting or tearing (fine-motor skill), as well as the opportunity to learn the names of colors (cognitive skill).*

#### **Materials:**

- Tissue paper in a variety of colors
- Glue
- Scissors
- Cardboard or construction paper for background

#### **What to do:**

1. Instruct the child to cut or tear tissue paper in a variety of sizes and shapes to glue onto a background.
2. Encourage the child to cover as much of the background as he wants.
3. Ask the child about his collage: Why did he choose the colors? Does his collage look like something specific?
