



BOOK TITLE: **Raindrop, Plop!**  
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**SUMMARY OF BOOK:** A little girl and her dog count things they find outside on a rainy day. Then they both come home to a warm, dry home.

**\*BEFORE READING** (Ask questions and use what the child already knows to add to the discussion, assisting the child in understanding and enjoying the book):

Let your child hold the book and turn the pages. Talk about the front and the back of the book. As your child turns the pages, talk about the pictures on each page.

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**DURING READING:**

1. Ask your child to point to the little girl and/or the dog on each page.
2. Talk about what they are doing.

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**AFTER READING** (activity to extend book experience):

1. On the next rainy day, dress your child in rain gear and go outside and splash in the puddles. Sing rainy day songs like "Rain, rain, go away, come again another day."
2. Count things you find outside on a rainy day.
