



BOOK TITLE: Tiger Can't Sleep
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SUMMARY OF BOOK: This story is about a boy trying to sleep, but there is a tiger in his closet making all kinds of noise! Finally the Tiger asks to sleep in the boy's bed and everything gets quiet – that is, until he starts snoring!

***BEFORE READING** (Ask questions and use what the child already knows to add to the discussion, assisting the child in understanding and enjoying the book):

Try questions such as these:

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DURING READING (ask these questions):

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| <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. How do you think the boy feels when he says there is a tiger in his closet? 2. What is the tiger doing in the closet? 3. Why won't the tiger be quiet so the boy can sleep? | <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 4. Can a tiger be a pet? Why or why not? 5. Do you ever have to be told something more than once? How does it make you feel? 6. Why might the tiger be crying? |
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AFTER READING (activity to extend book experience):

One of Tigers' many talents was playing an instrument. He played the drums, tuba, and even a banjo! Anything can be an instrument. Find three things around your house that can make music! (For example: pans, cups, boxes, pencils)
